**7.1. Treasurer's Report**

Marg Trnka described the difference between the active and passive systems which the new timing system is equally capable of recording. She said the active system required an expensive powered transponder, the passive does not. Currently she and Michal are working on the timing of the Birkie Classic, hoping for snow.

#### 7.5. Kangaroo Hoppet Race Committee

Nick Wright undertook to make this report tonight and at other times should Allan Marsland be absent. Nick reported on the last meeting of the committee. He said the committee will be looking for more young volunteers to assist in the setting up the Friday before the Hoppet. There will be two buses carrying competitors to Falls Creek not two as last year. Last year the third bus was not filled. Ben Derrick will chair the meetings of the committee and act as transport co-ordinator. Nick advised there were attractive t-shirts available for those who enter early.

#### 7.6. Clubhouse

There were some email exchanges about the thermostat. Tony Keeble urged that the thermostat not be altered from 16 degrees as it would use excessive electricity.

Doug will make a sign asking that the slab floor thermostat not be changed from 16 degrees.

#### 8.1. Victorian Snowsports Development Grants

She said a one day instructors' course was possible, or programs to encourage young people to the miniseries, the club races or support for cheaper skis, transport or more coaches.

#### 8.2. Mount Beauty Half Marathon

It was suggested at the AGM that the club might consider taking over the Half Marathon. Members asked where the profits for the event went, and it was thought they may be provided to the Chamber of Commerce. The members thought it might be incorporated into the school program and run by students. The matter will be re-agendaed and Allan Marsland or Helen L'Huillier might be asked to attend and brief the committee.

#### 8.3. Birkebeiner Ski Jacket

Members commented the Falls Creek shoulder logo could be expanded and placed on the right breast given it is the club ski base. Ronice supported the cost to junior club members should be subsidised

to reduce the price to \$75 for a junior size. This would apply to those who are under 18 at the end of December and financial club members.
