A small step in the right direction



Yesterday a 'Statement from the Board' was posted on the Falls Creek website.

They acknowledged that "the full all-year-round activation of the redeveloped ANARE shed would likely require the removal of snow from the key access road which provides transport to the Lakeside Precinct. This road currently forms the base of part of the cross country trail network."

Whilst the FCARMB has not made a decision with respect to clearing snow from the road and will not be doing so in its remaining term, community feedback is being sought on a range of opportunities for activation of the lakeside precinct. This includes working with clubs and user groups on the widening of other cross country access

options and new trail development to compensate if future changes are made to the current trail network.

This feedback will inform future strategic planning around the lakeside and its activation. In addition, the FCARMB will be recommending to the incoming ARV Board that a strategic review of XC skiing be undertaken as a priority project.

Whilst the FCARMB has not made a decision with respect to clearing snow from the road and will not be doing so in its remaining term, community feedback is being sought on a range of opportunities for activation of the lakeside precinct. This includes working with clubs and user groups on the widening of other cross country access options and new trail development to compensate if future changes are made to the current trail network.
