30 YEARS OF SKI DE FEMME

In 1993 the International Ski Federation (FIS) and the Australian Sports Commission Towards Gender Equity Program funded two Swedish female XC ski racers and a coach to come to Victoria and NSW to expose Australian girls and women to elite crosscountry skiing through clinics, seminars, and race participation.

Their visit inspired the first Ski De Femme in 1994 and BNSC has proudly run it every year since (except during Covid). With average participant numbers each year over 100, that makes thousands of girls and women who have had fun and learned some new skills on cross-country skis.

The event is run by volunteers and entry is free. Clinics are available for both novice and intermediate XC skiers in a choice of classic or skating techniques. Equipment can be hired from YMCA Falls Creek Cross Country at Windy Corner prior to the clinic.

Following the ski race there will be tea and scones, and a raffle. Many local businesses have kindly donated some great spot prizes.

XCSAV UPDATE & FC LAKESIDE DEVELOPMENT

The planning permit application for the re-development of the ANARE Shed at Falls Creek has been re-advertised with a range of changes, however, the impacts to cross country skiing are not addressed in the revised application. Clearing of the Bogong High Plains Road to the ANARE Shed in winter continues to be considered by ARV/FCRM.

Now is your opportunity to lodge an objection, if you have not done so, or to lodge another if you have additional objections to the new documentation submitted in the ANARE planning permit. If you have already submitted an objection, it still stands and will be considered in the planning approval process.
